#### I. Call to Order

The American Association of Orthopaedic Surgeons Board of Directors meeting was called to order by Felix H. Savoie, III, MD, FAAOS, President, at 7:00 p.m. CT

## II. <u>Strategic Goal 3: Governance and Culture</u>

## A. Update to Professional Relationships Standards of Professionalism

Recently, there have been a number of discussions about the need to address sexual harassment in orthopaedics. During his presidential term, Dr. Daniel Guy asked the Committee on Professionalism and the Judiciary Committee to consider and recommend revised language to the Professional Relationships Standard of Professionalism (SOP) that would more explicitly state that sexual harassment was unprofessional.

Ms. Melissa Young, AAOS General Counsel, addressed the Board and indicated that both the Committee on Professionalism and the Judiciary Committee felt the revised language referring to sexual harassment should broad and reference harassment more broadly. Ms. Young presented the following revised language on behalf of the Committee and Professionalism and the Judiciary Committee.

"An orthopaedic surgeon shall conduct himself or herself in a professional manner in interactions with colleagues or other health care professionals

Ms. Young added that if the Board was in agreement with the revised language for the SOP, a proposed change to the SOP would be submitted by the September 1, 2022 deadline for consideration by the Board of Councilors (BOC) and the Board of Specialty Societies (BOS) at the 2022 Combined NOLC / Fall Meeting.

Ms. Young entertained questions from the Board. Discussion ensued. The Board of Directors agreed on the need for the revised language and further amended the Professional Relationships Standard of Professionalism.

Dr. Savoie entertained a motion and second to amend the Professional Relationships Standard of Professionalism as follows:

"An orthopaedic surgeon shall conduct himself or herself in a professional manner in interactions with colleagues or other healthcare professionals. This includes, but is not limited to, avoiding behavior that is harassing, bullying or discriminatory."
