

AAOS Annual Meeting Disclosure Policy

As an accredited provider of continuing medical education (CME) the Academy is required by the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (ACCME) to obtain and share with participants of any AAOS CME activity any potential conflicts of interest by faculty, program developers, and CME planners.

The ACCME Standards of Commercial Support, Standard 2 states that the provider must be able to show that everyone who is in a position to control the content of an education activity has disclosed all relevant financial relationships with any commercial interest to the provider. The AAOS disclosure policy requires that faculty submit their disclosure in the AAOS Orthopaedic Disclosure Program.

A current disclosure is required to participate in the Annual Meeting. If you have not completed or updated your disclosure since April 1, 2022, you must do so at this time by going to www.aaos.org/disclosure, log in and complete or update your disclosure.

This is mandatory for your participation, regardless of your relationship to AAOS.
