COURSE LOCATION

The course will take place at the Grand Summit Hotel, 4000 Canyons Resort Drive, Park City, UT, 84098. Visit Parkcitymountain.com to download the My Epic app today and activate Mobile Pass. Plus turn on GPS tracking to track your on-mountain stats and more.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION AND PARKING

The Grand Summit Hotel is situated 35 miles from Salt Lake City International Airport, approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes away. If you are staying in Canyons Village (Grand Summit Hotel, Silverado Lodge Hotel, or the Sundial Lodge Hotel), your reservation includes one complimentary parking pass. For those commuting daily to attend the meeting, please drive up to the main entrance of the Grand Summit Hotel and approach the bell staff for parking assistance. Please be aware that there could be a daily \$25 per vehicle parking fee, and all transactions will be cashless.

Canyon Transportation is the recommended ground transportation service to and from the Salt Lake City International Airport to the Grand Summit Hotel. Reservations can be made online at: Canyon Transportation. You can also book by calling 801-255-1841. Please mention group code **AAOS24** to apply a 10% discount to your selected service.

Toyota Courtesy Vehicle: Grand Summit is pleased to offer a Toyota Courtesy Vehicle, seating up to 6 guests. It runs on a constant loop between Grand Summit Hotel and Swede Alley (Main Street) from 11:00am - 9:00pm daily (first ride leaving GSH at 11am, last ride back to GSH 8:30pm), with expanded hours of service (8:00am – 10:00pm) on Saturdays starting December 23, 2023. Traffic may alter this timeline.

HOTEL CHECK-IN & CHECK OUT

Check-in at The Grand Summit hotel starts at 4:00 pm MT. Guests are welcome to check in earlier if the room is ready; however, for those arriving before 4:00 pm, room availability is not guaranteed. In the event your room is not ready, a bellman will be happy to store your luggage. Priority for room cleaning will be given to guests who arrive early, and a front desk agent will reach out to you once your room is prepared.

The Sundial Lodge and Silverado Lodge Hotel's front desks close at 11:00pm MT. After that, all guests must check in at the Grand Summit Hotel.
